**Medicare is a medical insurance and only covers the medical aspect of your eye examination. Medicare does not have a Vision Plan and does not cover glasses, contact lenses or Refractions.**

**A Refraction is the portion of the exam where the Doctor determines if there is any need to change the power of your glasses or contact lenses. It is not always necessary if your current glasses are working well for you, but if you are interested or need new glasses, you will need to have a Refraction before any glasses prescription can be released.**
